Dear Valued Customer:

Additional cost increases for raw materials used to manufacture PVC Packaging Films including those for resin, plasticizer, and processing aids, along with significant increases in the cost of packaging materials, make it necessary for Berry Plastics Corporation (Pliant) to raise its prices by 8% March 8th on all films. They include Supermarket, Cutter Box, Meat Processor, Converter, Laundry Wrap and Specialty Films. This increase is in addition to the 8% increase announced January 5, 2010.

The March 8% increase is effective with orders placed Monday, March 8th. Orders calling for your **normal monthly order requirements**, placed prior to close of business Friday, March 5th and specifying immediate will call or shipment, will be invoiced at pre-increase price levels.

Berry Plastics Corporation (Pliant) appreciates your business and understanding of the necessity of increasing prices due to rapidly rising costs.
